The undersigned is directed to refer to CBEC's letter No.450/16/2015-Cus.IV dated 16.3.2017 on the subject mentioned above and to say the matter has been examined in this Department.

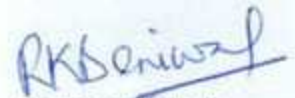
In the above context, it is mentioned that presently, the Department has identified the following 7 tariff lines from Chapter 21 for Risk Management:

ITC HS Code	Testing Protocol	Descriptions
21039090	NT	Other
21041010	NT	Dried
21041090	NT	Other
21042000	NT	Homogenised composite food preparations
21050000	RT	Ice-cream and other edible ice, whether or not containing cocoa
21061000	NT	Protein concentrates and textured protein substances
21069099	RT	Others

On further examination, it has been decided that only tariff line code no. 21050000 pertaining to Ice-cream and other edible ice, whether or not containing cocoa as mentioned above will be regulated under SIP regime for which prior SIP from DADF would be required for import.

In so far as the remaining six tariff lines from chapter 21 as mentioned above are concerned the import consignment under the same may be cleared by AQCS based on the FSSAI clearance and fulfillment of following conditions:

- Product should be accompanied by the certificate stating that the product is fit for human consumption,
- Product indicating green or red dot,
- Product label should indicate the ingredient details.
