Subject: Procedure for import of dairy items.

I am directed to say that the as per the requirements of Food Safety Standard Authority of India(FSSAI), Food business operators handling dairy products require licence under Rule 50 of Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954. This is applicable for imported dairy products also.

Therefore, all the importers applying for Sanitary Import Permits for import of dairy products are requested to provide a copy of valid licence issued by PFA Authority at the time of filing the application for Sanitary Import Permit. Please note that the application will not be processed if the said licence is not attached with the application. Further, the undertaking as per enclosed format would also be required at the time of filing an application for dairy products.
