  - have been chemically treated in conditions maintained at a minimum pH 11.5 or a maximum of pH 12 for at least 48 hours. (optional)
  - have been treated for at least 28 days with sea salt (sodium chloride) containing a biocide or biocide mixture equivalent to sea salt (Na Cl) treatment. (optional)
  - have been treated by gamma radiation at a dose of at least 20 kGy at room temperature (20 degrees or higher). (optional)
  - after treatment have been packed with new, clean, fresh packing materials which satisfy the necessary sanitary hygiene requirements.
  - Necessary precautions were taken after collection and processing to avoid contact of products with any potential source of infection.
  - Anthrax, sheep pox and goat pox do not occur in New Zealand.
